Summary of Ordering Steps

This guide provides an overview of the key steps required to order SUSVIMO® (ranibizumab injection)



Tip: If this is your first time ordering SUSVIMO, review these steps before the patient is scheduled for their procedure, as some steps (e.g., specialty distributor account setup) may require lead time.

STEP 1

Specialty Distributor Selection and Setup(2026)

SUSVIMO® (ranibizumab injection) may be purchased through any of the following authorized specialty distributors

To purchase SUSVIMO from a specialty distributor, you will need to register with one of the authorized distributors.

- If you are already registered with one of these distributors, confirm that your registration aligns to the corresponding business units below (e.g., McKesson). If not, you will need to create a new account

Non-hospital centers: Once you have a specialty distributor selected, request that your distributor enrolls you in the Genentech Ophthalmology Discount Program at least 15 days prior to ordering.

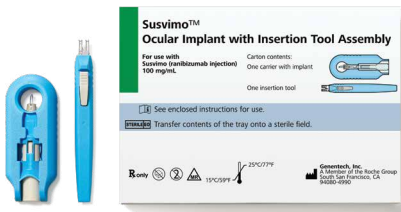

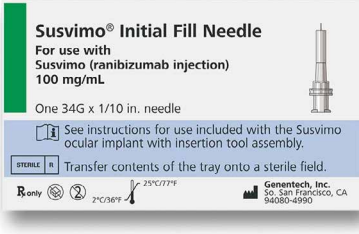

Additional Required Materials for the SUSVIMO[®] (ranibizumab injection) Implant Procedure



- 3.5-mm and 4.0-mm fixed caliper or equivalent fixed tool
- 3.5-mm fixed-width gauge or equivalent fixed tool



Please note:

- These are required for the procedure but are not standard equipment in an operating room
- The fixed caliper and fixed-width gauge used during Genentech clinical trials were ordered from Corza
- These materials are reusable

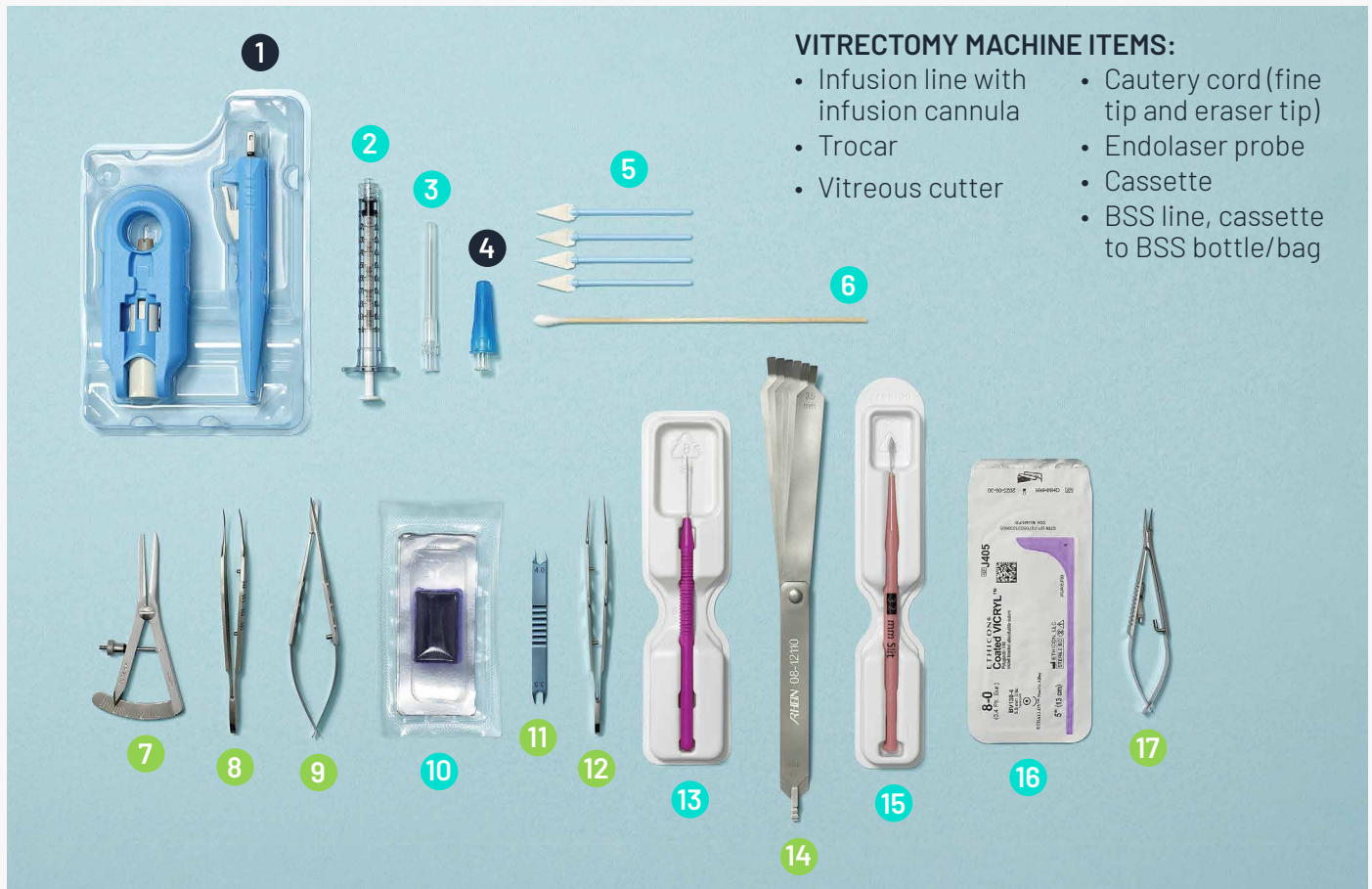

1	SUSVIMO insertion tool carrier (left) and handle (right)
2	Tuberculin syringe (1 mL, Luer lock tip)
3	5-micron filter needle (19-gauge, 1.5 inch)
4	SUSVIMO initial fill needle, 34G, with blue cap
5	Weck-Cel sponges
6	Cotton tip applicator
7	Adjustable caliper
8	Non-tooth forceps
9	Blunt Westcott scissors
10	Marking pad/purple ink
11	3.5 mm and 4.0 mm fixed caliper <i>or equivalent fixed tool*</i>
12	0.12 straight toothed forceps
13	19G or 20G MVR straight knife
14	3.5 mm fixed width gauge <i>or equivalent fixed tool*</i>
15	Slit knife, 3.2 mm straight
16	Gut or Vicryl sutures for conjunctival tissues (suggested 7-0 to 9-0: monofilament recommended)
17	Needle holder

SUSVIMO explant tool (not pictured) must be on-hand for all SUSVIMO procedures.†
